



AFTER CEMENTING YOUR CROWN OR BRIDGE

You may eat immediately.

Your tooth may become temporarily sensitive again.

- It should calm down quickly.

If your tooth has remained sensitive, it should stop.

- It is not unusual for it to remain so for a few days.

Tender, bleeding gums are not cause for concern.

- Brush and floss the tooth normally and bleeding should stop within 3 days.
- Rinse with warm salt water until gum tenderness stops.

(Over)

Allow one or two days for the bite to feel right.

- Call us if you are uncomfortable at any time.
- At first the bite is sometimes difficult to adjust because of numbness from the procedure.

In about two weeks, call us and let us know how you are doing.
